Excavation Site — Work is progressing at the historic homesite near Richmond where we are currently excavating. FBAS volunteers dig every Saturday morning. Want a closer look? In the top left image, Bob Crosser looks on as FBAS members work on several pits. Multiple pits are open as we expose the perimeter of the root cellar. Once the cellar has been documented we'll close the pits. The photo on the top right shows a sample of some of the glass being recovered. We're excited about the root cellar but we are also finding lots of little artifacts. This includes many of the typical things we find such as glass, ceramic, ferrous metal bits, nails, shell, brick, etc. Top photos by John Rich.





Here's an image showing the stark contrast between the light color of the root cellar and the darker color of the undisturbed soil outside of the root celler. In addition to the smaller artificats we're finding, we're also uncovering some larger artifacts. In the top left of the pit above, there is a large piece of flat iron with a small cylindrical bottle in the corner. We wonder if the metal could be a piece of a wood buring stove. The image on the right is a closer look at the small bottle after it was removed from the excavation unit.
